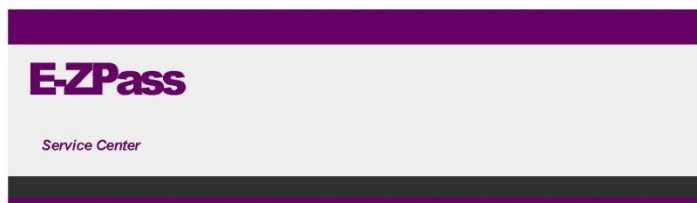
Ohio Turnpike warns its *E-ZPass*® customers of email scam

BEREA (July 14, 2014) – The Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (OTIC) warns its approximately 150,000 customers not to open or respond to an email from “E-ZPass Info,” as seen below.

“The emails were not sent by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission and they are likely an attempt to steal personal information or funds from unsuspecting customers,” said OTIC Executive Director Richard Hodges. “This warning may help prevent the Turnpike’s valued *E-ZPass* customers from being scammed.”

This e-mail scam has also been reported in the states of New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Massachusetts and the District of Columbia.
