### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (“RFP”) FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR SWANTON MAINTENANCE BUILDING ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION PROJECT OHIO TURNPIKE COMMISSION**

The Ohio Turnpike Commission (“Commission”) will be issuing a RFP to select a qualified consulting firm to perform Engineering Design and Construction Administration and Inspection Services for Environmental Remediation to take place at the Commission’s Swanton Maintenance Building located at Milepost 48.3 in Lucas County, Ohio.

Any firm interested in submitting a Letter of Interest (“LOI”) to respond to the RFP is invited to do so by **5:00 p.m., EDT, June 24, 2008**. **LOI’s should include general information as to why the Firm believes it is qualified to perform the services required for a Project of this type. (See page 2 of this Notice for further details on content of the LOI). One (1) original and three (3) copies of the LOI are required.** Once the Commission has reviewed the LOI’s received, it will select several interested and qualified Firms in order to elicit sufficient responses to the RFP. The Selected Firms will then be invited to submit a response to the RFP. The deadline for responses to the RFP will be **2:00 p.m., EDT, July 15, 2008**.

Interested firms are advised that, to be considered to respond to the RFP, a completed response to the Commission’s “2007/2008 Biennial Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Construction Engineering & Inspection Services, et. seq.” (hereinafter, “the 2007/2008 RFQ”), must also be on file with the Commission. The 2007/2008 RFQ package may be obtained from the Commission’s Purchasing Manager, Kevin Golick.

Firms interested in reviewing the RFP may request a draft copy from the Commission’s Purchasing Manager. Interested Firms may submit specific questions regarding the RFP and/or the LOI requirements. Any questions **shall** be addressed in writing and **emailed to [kevin.golick@ohioturnpike.org](mailto:kevin.golick@ohioturnpike.org) or faxed to 440-234-0232 Attn.: Kevin Golick. Please do not contact the Commission by phone. Do not address your questions to anyone other than Mr. Golick.** The Inquiry Deadline for the RFP is **5:00 p.m. EDT, July 8, 2008**. However, remember that inquiries concerning the LOI requirements must be submitted with sufficient time for the Commission to respond prior to the June 24, 2008 LOI deadline. A summary of all questions and answers will be compiled. Firms that so request will be forwarded a copy of each question and the Commission’s response. 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## LETTER OF INTEREST CONTENT (Not to exceed ten pages)

1. List the types/categories of services for which your firm has submitted a Qualification Statement in response to the 2007/2008 RFQ. List significant subconsultants, their categories of service and the percentage of work to be performed by each proposed subconsultant.
2. List the proposed Project Manager and other key staff members including key subconsultant staff. Address the experience of the key staff members on similar projects. Provide only the résumé of the proposed Project Manager. ~~The proposed Project Manager shall be a professional engineer registered in the State of Ohio.~~
3. Provide references from three governmental organizations other than the Ohio Turnpike Commission for similar remediation design projects completed in the past five years. For each reference/project listed provide a contact name and phone number.
4. Describe the capacity of your firm's staff and its ability to perform the work in a timely manner relative to present workload and the availability of assigned staff.
5. Provide a description of your Project approach, not to exceed two pages. Confirm the firm's proposed technical approach, cost containment practices, innovative ideas for this type of project and any other relevant information concerning your firm's qualifications to perform the services contemplated.

Items 1-5 must be included in the LOI, which should not exceed ten pages on single sided, 8 1/2" x 11" sheets of paper. To be considered, **one original and three copies of the LOI must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. EDT, June 24, 2008.**
