

Part-time Toll Collector

The Ohio Turnpike & Infrastructure Commission is currently seeking applications for the position of Part-Time Toll Collector. We are seeking applicants for primarily the Western District – Exits 2 - Exit 91 and Eastern District Exits 180 – Exit 239.

Qualified applicants must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. Prior experience working with customers and handling cash transactions required. Must successfully pass math test, criminal and credit background check. Required to stand for long periods of time. Must be able to lift boxes of tickets and monies and bend and reach various heights. Must be able to process toll transactions, handle money accurately, work with the general public in a polite and professional manner, use radio communication equipment, and stand for long periods of time.

Salary

Starting pay for toll collectors is \$16.54 per hour in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement. Salary rate increases with OTIC service. There are no medical benefits associated with this position.

Hours of Work & Locations

Position requires working weekdays, evenings, weekends, holidays and fluctuating hours based upon employee seniority. Applicants must have full availability to be considered for employment. You must be able to work varying shifts throughout the 24-hour/7 day week. Applicants with current full-time employment and/or a rigid work schedule cannot be considered for this position. Applicants must designate work hours availability and location(s) preferred on the employment application to be considered for employment. Employees do not pay tolls to and from their assigned work installation(s).

The Ohio Turnpike & Infrastructure Commission cannot guarantee a number of work hours or wages for part-time toll collectors. Hours of work are dependent upon the operational needs of the Commission and pursuant to language defined in the collective bargaining agreement.
