

OHIO TURNPIKE AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

Resolution Rejecting the Sole Bid Received on Project No. 58-24-04

WHEREAS, the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (“Commission”) published a notice in accordance with law to advertise an Invitation to Bid on a contract for a New Mainline Toll Plaza 239 Sign at Milepost 239, in Mahoning County, Ohio, designated as Project No. 58-24-04 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Commission received one (1) bid to perform the Contractor’s obligations on the Project, and the Chief Engineer/Deputy Executive Director’s report analyzing the bid is before the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 5537.07(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as the Instructions to Bidders, provide that the Commission may reject any and all bids; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Engineer/Deputy Executive Director reports that the bid submitted by A.P. Horo Company is 73.9% greater than the Engineer’s estimate and because the bid is such a high percentage above the Engineer’s Estimate, the Chief Engineer/Deputy Executive Director recommends that the Commission reject the bid to allow for Engineering staff to further evaluate the requirements for the project; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Executive Director concurs with the recommendation that the Commission reject the sole bid received on the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has duly considered said recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission that the sole bid received in response to Project No. 58-24-04 is rejected.
