ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED THROUGH 5:00 P.M. ON JUNE 20, 2024:

Q#6 Can you please advise if the lid must be plastic or can it be steel?

A#6 Steel rain bonnet is acceptable.

The (metal) bonnet design must match the spec and bonnet must fit the container appropriately, as designed by Barco. The bonnet must be secured to the lid, as originally designed by Barco.

Based on the foregoing, the Specification has been revised as follows (changes shown in red):

Group I / Item III: – Rain Bonnet for 45 Gal. Recycled Slat Trash Receptacle

Description

To keep trash dry from the elements, top load 45 Gallon model receptacles shall have an added rain bonnet lid as follows:

- Dimensions: 22.75" l x 22.75" w x 8.75" h
- Material: HDPE **or Steel**
- Color: Black
- An engraved, resin-filled message: TRASH
- Compatible with top load 45-gallon Recycled Plastic Slat Design Round receptacles
- Rain bonnet shall ship fully assembled and must be attached to rigid flat lid either prior to shipping or on-site by shipper.
